ELIGIBILITY: For 2025, any dancer having achieved Honours or Honours Distinction in an NDAAI examination from Highland Grade 3 to Advanced, any Scottish National examination SN 1 to SN 8, or any Jig and Hornpipe exam in 2024 is eligible to enter. Dancers who have successfully gained their Teacher's Certificate are **not** eligible to enter the Scholarship.

<u>ATTIRE:</u> Dancers must wear either a black leotard or black fitted top (no insignia or logo) with black bike shorts or sport shorts no longer than mid-thigh and knee high white socks with hair in a bun or pulled back off face if it is short

PRIZE: There is a \$300.00 cash prize for the overall winner of each age group plus \$150 for 2nd and \$100 for 3rd placegetters in each age group, making a total of \$1,100 prize money. The overall placegetters will also receive a certificate in recognition of their award, and all other dancers will receive a participation certificate.

The three sections (Theory, Amalgamations and Choreography) will have placings from 1st through to 3rd, then these will be scrutineered to get the overall 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners in each age group.

FORMAT: There are three sections to the scholarship.

- 1) **Theory Paper**: A multiple choice theory paper approx. 30 mins in duration.
- 2) **Amalgamations**: Dancers in the 14yrs and U will learn three amalgamations using basic movements from the Fling, Sword Dance, and the Seann Triubhas. In the Senior category, there will be four amalgamations using basic movements from the Highland Fling, Sword Dance, Seann Triubhas and Reel.
- 3) **Choreography**: Each dancer will have to perform a solo choreography dance with a time limit of 1½ minutes. Music must be Scottish/Celtic and may have lyrics. Costume to be the dancer's choice but tasteful and respectful to highland dancing.

Steps to be 85 – 90% highland dancing movements.

Parents, Teachers, and any interested people are all welcome and invited to watch with an observer's fee of \$10.00 payable on entry.
